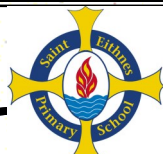

Pet Dogs

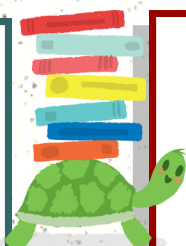
